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KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Jeanette Sakel is a German/British linguist and educator. She gained her PhD at the Max Planck Germany and the University of Nijmegen, The Netherlands (2003) and has since held positions at the University of Manchester (UK) and the University of the West of England (UK).

She has written 3 books and edited a further 4, alongside approximately 30 peer-reviewed journal articles and book chapters. Jeanette was awarded a highly esteemed National Teaching Fellowship in 2015. She is leading on learning and teaching matters as Director of Student Experience, with a keen interest in engaging students in their learning, using digital tools to their full potential to ensure an inclusive education for all.



Prof. Dr. Hj. Aan Komariah, M.Pd is an education administration scholar in Indonesia. Currently, She serves as Vice Chair Professor at the Indonesian University of Education (UPI), Head of Teacher Professional Education Program, UPI. She has been a Visiting Professor at Dong Hwa University, Hanoi National University, and University of Malaya. Prof. Komariah's main research interests include educational administration, educational leadership, teaching and learning, and education management.

Prof Aan now is the Editor-in-Chief of the Educational Administration Research and Review Journal. She has authored and co-authored more than 100 articles, from which more than 53 articles are indexed in the Scopus/Wos Citation Index database. His research series on educational leadership, school management, and teaching and learning has been published in the form of reference books, monographs, and book chapters.

MUHAMMAD ZULFAJRI took his Bachelor's degree at Syiah Kuala University in 2005-2009 majoring in the Chemistry Education. Then, funded by the Aceh Government Scholarship, he continued pursuing his master's degree at National Sun Yat-sen University Taiwan from 2012 to 2014, and Pei-Ying Scholarship his doctoral degree at Kaohsiung Medical University from 2017 to 2021, both majoring in Chemistry. Currently, he is a lecturer at the Chemistry Education Study Program of Serambi Mekkah University (since 2015). Apart from being a lecturer, he is also a teacher at Dayah Darul Ihsan Abu Hasan Krueng Kalee (since 2007), an assessor for BAN SM Aceh Province (since 2021), and a facilitator for Sekolah Penggerak since 2022.

His research focuses on the synthesis of nanomaterials, chemical sensors, environmental protection, and analytical environmental, and materials-based chemistry education. His various research results have been published in reputable national and international journals.



Dr. Zawawi Ismail is an Associate Professor and currently the Dean of the Faculty of Education, University of Malaya, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. He received his Bachelor Degree in Arabic Language & Literature (Major), Shariah (Minor) from Yarmouk University, Jordan, Post Graduate Diploma of Education from International Islamic University Malaysia, Master in Arabic Education and obtained his Ph.D. in the field of Education from the National University of Malaysia 2008.

His research interests include Arabic & Islamic Education Curriculum, Teacher Education, Muslim Minority Education, and Quranic Language Education.

He has published articles in international and national journals, books and other publications. Dr. Zawawi has contributed a lot to society and he is also active in several NGOs and one of the founders of Yayasan As-Syafie which is focusing on developing Islamic Boarding School in Cambodia and other educational activities in Indonesia and Malaysia.
